I alway drag my heals with handing in my directors notes in a timely fashion. And, I usually wait until I have to be pestered. I believe it's because I don't necessarily like to talk about the show or the process or the why much. It's always changing.

Kelley Marchant and I have known one another a very long time and have, for years, wanted to work together again but the right project just hadn't revealed itself.

I've wanted to direct Romeo and Juliet for several years but always felt I needed kids to play the kids and adults to play adults . It's a large cast and the show is bigger than I believe most folks realize. It's been daunting to find the right circumstances to do it. The more Kelley brought me into work with her students, the more it became clear that the play ought to be done here -- at Rex Putnam -- with these fantastic students and a great group of adults from the community, some professional and some not.

I feel this is a world that lives in a visceral, hot blooded, and very passionate place. All of these characters feel deeply and hold deeply to their convictions. How interesting is it to try to think about why you're angry at somebody over something, and consider what is the cost of holding on to it. And, how quickly, with a first glance one can see great hope. It's naive to believe that something so innocent can mend the wounds of so many years.... I love this story because it is so spontaneous and electric. This is a ball rolling down the hill, it is an emotional ride for all who take it.

I want to thank Kelley Marchant, Kristen Mun, Clara Hillier, and Alwynn Accuardi, and all the adult actors for working around a tight schedule. And, a big thank you to the parents who have taken the time to help support these amazing young artists.


